

## Collision Summary: Rode Village

Data range: 01/12/2017 – 30/11/2022

There have been **no** personal injury collisions recorded in any of the streets that have been chosen to have some of the lighting turned off in the most current five-year period.

Using the collision data between 1/12/2017 and 30/11/22 it can be shown that there was a total of 13 collisions (2 serious & 11 slight) within the Rode built-up area resulting in 16 casualties (2 serious and 14 slight injury). The two KSI collisions account for 15% of the total collisions.

Collisions have occurred at the following locations:

10 (77%) out of the 13 collisions occurred during daylight hours. There were 3 Vulnerable Road Users (VRUs) involved in the 13 collisions, 1 motorcyclist, 1 pedal cyclist and 1 pedestrian. 5 (42%) of the collisions occurred when the road surface was wet/damp and 1 when the road was described as being affected by frost/ice.
