Record of Graves in Churchyard

This record is compiled from a small notebook of burials and inscriptions on the gravestones and memorials in the chapel.

The notebook is dated 20.1.1860 but burial information was not recorded in it until 1927, although some earlier burials have been entered.^(?)

Records in the notebook are only of the grave number and name of those interred.

Many graves no longer have gravestones and some of the remaining gravestones are badly weathered.

This file was compiled in September 2007 and last updated in February 2008
