AutoSpeedWatch report for the complete calendar month of May.

AutoSpeedWatch at Bradford Road, Rode (B3109 northbound), 30mph limit.

Approaching (150 yards) mandatory 'Stop' crossroads at Rode Hill

Note that this is a dangerous junction. Two of the other approaches to the junction have illuminated flashing warning signs, recently installed by Somerset District Council.

The ASW does not operate in times of darkness: naturally, available hours have been longer in May than in April.

In the period 01-05-2024 to 30-05-2024 (30 days approximately), in daylight hours only

Our ASW has recorded, and we have verified, **3,538** vehicles travelling at **40mph or over**.

There were **69** vehicles travelling at **50mph or over** (the highest at **58 mph**).

There were **318** persistent (repeat) speeders in the active period, the most prolific showing **12** offences.

ASW estimates that 37,332 vehicles passed through the location in the active period, with an estimated average speed of 34.0 mph, and an estimated 85th percentile speed of 47.0 mph (this is 'the speed that 85% of vehicles were travelling slower than').
