## Rode Weather Report for September 2024

The following is a summary of the key readings on my Davis Vantage Vue weather station located in the middle of our back garden in Rode.

I have put the readings in a table and shown the equivalent readings since my first September readings in 2020 soon after I had installed the system.

<sup>\*</sup> Note the correct figure is likely to have been about 8mm greater than 198.0mm: my weather station developed a brief fault when it stopped recording for a few hours during some quite heavy rain. I estimated 8mm from figures from neighbouring weather stations.

I spent most of the second half of September in Victoria on Vancouver Island where I experienced some delightful early autumn/fall weather with warm temperatures, light winds and quite a bit of sunshine. But it seems the UK was experiencing rather different weather.

From the figures above it is immediately clear that September 2024 has been an exceptionally wet and cool month. The average measured rainfall for the previous 4 Septembers was 58.6mm. This month it has been 198.0mm! In 2022 Mike Cooper gave the Frome September 21-year average as 66.5mm and the highest recorded September rainfall was 152mm in 1999. So this year easily broke that record. 50.6mm fell on 22-23 Sept exceeding the 40.8mm total recorded for Sept 2020.

Temperatures were also down. From 2020 to 2023 each year's maximum recorded temperature averaged 29.75°C. This year a maximum for the month of only 23.0°C was reached on the 19<sup>th</sup> which was the *average* daily maximum last year. This year's average daily maximum was only 18°C.
